

- Example: You^{3+F} Thanked Mohamed
 1. (610,9,3) is used to get the pronouns. You^{3+F} is أَنْتَ
 2. (1130,9,3) is used to get the sounding of the verbs (Wazn) فَعَلْتَنَ.
 3. Change the verb شَكَرَ to شَكَرْتَنَ because it sounds like (Wazn) فَعَلْتَنَ
 4. Remember that the object is Mansoub. Use Table 290, col 5, to get the proper Harakah
- Given the verb شَكَرَ, which sounds like فَعَلَ, translate the following table.
