Translate the following sentences, make I'rab and put the Tashkeel on its words. I have done one example for you to follow. You don't have to provide the explanation, just do the I'rab.

You<sup>2M or 2F</sup> plant the dates

تَزْرَعَانِ التَّمْرَ

Rule 820 says that the default case for the present tense verbs are always Marfoo^ with Damah. Here the Damah is silent (hidden) because the verb is connected to a pronoun.	فعل مضارع مرفوع بالضممة الساكنة Past tense verb hidden Fatha	تَزْرَعُ
The subject is pronoun. Using the rule 810 table, we find that we add "انِ" at the end of "تَزْرَعُ" for the case of "You <sup>2M or 2F</sup> ".	ضمير فاعل Pronoun subject "You <sup>2M or 2F</sup> "	انِ
Rule 630 says that the object is always Mansoob. Because the object here is irregular plural noun, rule 180 says that the haraka for Mansoob is Fatha. No Tanween is required because it has Alif-Lam.	مفعول به منصوب بالفتحة Object Mansoob with Fatha	التَّمْرَ
