
# The Name of Allah "العزيز Almighty.

#### Introduction:

- Meaning of Al-Azeez: The most powerful and most mighty. Having unlimited power, able to do anything. I have so much power that no one can mess with me, insult me, make me angry or disobey me without my permission. We all seek the approval of the Azeez and please him. If we do, then life is good and we are protected. Allah gives the freedom to bad people to disobey and insult him as part of the test of submission.
- Insult Allah. He made a mistake, He doesn't know what he is doing, He takes a nap, he is having a meal, he is cruel, he needs middle Gods, he is not aware of what is happening, ...etc.

# Language meaning of Izah.

Pyramids of Izah (Power) (such as in Surat Yusuf, Azeez Misr).

## Islamic meaning of Al-Azeez

- 1. Al-Azeez means the powerful. Shared this meaning with the Al-Qawy
- 2. Al-Aziz, the one whose power envelops everything. No one has power to be outside of the Izah of Al-Azeez. No one has power to act outside of the Izah of Al-Azeez. No

- one can harm Allah or escape from his power and dominion (sovereignty, control, supremacy).
- 3. The one whom we must seek protection from and no one can protect you against him. He gives you the real protection against all other powers. You can turn to him to seek his protection against enemies, but no one can protect you from him. This gives us the sense of security because if you have the protection of the Al-Azeez, then who can harm you. At the same time who can protect you from him.

## True Source of Izzah.

- Allah called the Quran Kitab Azeez. Fosilat41 :41 41 (وَإِنَّهُ لَكِتَابِهُ عَزِيرٌ Quran is powerful and provides protection. You turn to the book for protection. Protection of the heart, mind and body. When you are physically in harm you recite Ayat Al-Korsi, Surat Yaseen,

#### Fake Sources of Izzah.

- Why is the Izzah of the Pharaoh fake Izzah? The magicians of the Pharaoh that competed with Prophet Musa. What kind of Izzah they were seeking before the competition and then what kind of Izzah they seeked after the competition? What did the Pharaoh do to them?

## Facts:

- The second most mentioned name of Allah. The top five names (Allah, Al-Raheem, Al-Gafoor, Al-Gaffar, Al-Azeez) Mentioned 99 times as a proper noun.
- The most common combination is Al-Azeez Al-Hakeem (50 times in the Quran). It is among the most common combinations among Al-Gafoor Al-Raheem and others.
- Al-Hakeem the one with infinite Wisdom. Why do they were combined in the
  Quran. Because in our communities in earth, it is a general rule that power corrupts
  the intellect. Philosophers are not politicians. Our politicians typically lack wisdom.
  They don't act wisely. Their power corrupts them. Their power make them act in a
  foolish manner. Kings don't act wisely
- وكذلك } .. قال الرجم عرَّ وجلٌ {إن الملوك إذا دخلوا قرية أفسدوها وجعلوا أعزة أهلها أذلة } . قالت بلقيس

- It is very rare to meet a wise politician. To them it is all about myself, my power and they fail to act wisely.
- The more power a dictator has, the more despised him from his people. Even though he might have power, but he can never gain the hearts of the people. Allah has the power to make people love and respect his power at the same time.
- I am the one whose power has reached an infinite amount and that did not corrupt my infinite wisdom. My wisdom is not coming from weakness. My power doesn't corrupt my wisdom and my wisdom is based on power.
- Al-Azeez Al-Raheem came 13 times. When you gain power, you become hard hearted. You are no longer sympathetic to the poor and weak. You don't care about the weak; you care about the rich and elites. Reality across humanity that when you mix with the rich and elites, your heart started being attracted to them and you no longer care about the rich and week. To Allah: My power does not corrupt my Rahma.
- العرير الغيور، العرير الغيال We feel it is easier to forgive when we are weak. To Allah: I am the one full of power and still forgives.


## Prove you believe in the Name of Allah Al-Azeez.

How are we tested if we believe of the name of Allah Al-Aziz?

Q. What would you do if an earthly super power is forcing you to disobey the highest super duper Azeez (Almighty) (Allah), such as the case in the inquisition?

A. First try to escape to a place where you are free to obey Al-Azeez. If you can't (such as the case of African American slaves), then keep your heart with Al-Azeez.
