

Translate to Arabic and do the proper Tashkil. Memorize the vocab.
I have done an example below.

Procedure to follow:

- To demonstrate the procedure, we will be using the following example:
They^{3+M} harvested the crops.
 1. Using rule 610, row 14, column 3, (610,14,3), They^{3+M} is “هُم”
 2. Using Arabic-English dictionary, the word “harvested” is “حَصَدَ”, which is the root of the past tense verb. Note that the root of the past tense verb is for “He”. (1130, 10, 3), shows the root of the verb, which is “فَعَلَ”.
 3. The equivalent of “حَصَدَ” is “فَعَلَ”.
 4. (1130, 14, 3) shows that the past tense of “They^{3+M}” is “فَعَلُوا”, the equivalent is “حَصَدُوا”.
 5. Using Arabic-English dictionary, the word “the crops” is “الْمَحْصُول”. The word “the crops” is an object. The object is Mansob Rule 1050. The Mansob for irregular plural is Fatha (290,2,5). Tanwin is not allowed because of the Alif-Lam (285-1).
 6. Combining the words together gives “هُم حَصَدُوا الْمَحْصُول”

- **Reminder:** The following procedure is how to convert the singular noun into the proper gender and count. For example, to change nouns from single form into the desired form you do:
 1. Rule 230-1 All male dual nouns are made of the single noun then adding to the end either Alif Noon (اِنِ), if Marfo3, or Ya’a Noon (يِنِ), if Mansob or Majror.
 2. Rule 230-2 All male dual nouns are made of the single noun then convert the female Ta’a into open Ta’a, then adding to the end either Alif Noon (تَانِ), if Marfo3, or Ya’a Noon (تَيْنِ), if Mansob or Majror.
 3. Rule 235-1: Regular male plural nouns are made of the singular form with either Waw Noon (وُنَ), if Marfo3, or Ya’a Noon (يِنَ), if Mansob or Majror, added to the end
 4. Rule 235-2: The regular female plural is made by replacing the female Ta’a with Alif-Ta’a (ات)
